

Garden Flowers 13" X 13" Wall Hanging
Using the Chicks on the Run fabric line by Benartex



Materials needed:

One Chicks on the Run fabric panel
#3110-79

1/8 yard for sashing
#3117-44 Green

3/8 yard for border/binding/backing
#3114-10 Dark red

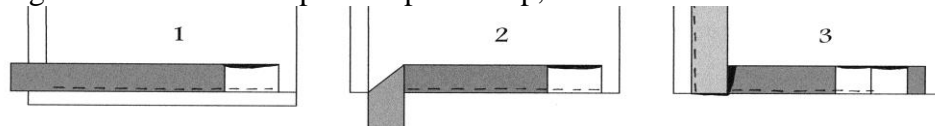
Cutting:

Green sashing fabric
Cut 2 1-1/2" strips

Red border fabric
Cut off 13-1/2" x 13-1/2" for backing

Then from the remainder
Cut 2 2-1/4" strips (border)
Cut 2 more 2-1/4" strips (binding)

1. Trim the panel picture to the outside the red edge all the way around.
2. It should measure approximately 7-1/2" x 7-3/4" wide.
3. Sew one green sashing strip to each side and trim the excess on the ends to match the panel.
4. Press all seams as you sew.
5. Sew the remaining green sashing strip to the top and bottom and trim the excess.
6. Sew one red border strip to each side and trim the excess.
7. Sew the remaining red border strip to the top and bottom and trim the excess.
8. Lay the quilt top on a layer of batting and backing fabric. Quilt by hand or machine.
9. Sew the binding strips of border fabric end to end, making a continuous strip of binding for the quilt.
10. Fold in half lengthwise, with right sides out, and press flat.
11. Pin around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the quilt.
12. Sew the binding face down to the top of the pieced top, miter each corner.



13. Overlap the ends. Fold over to the back, pin, and hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.

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
