

**Sunshine Chicks 18" X 20" Wall Hanging**  
Using the Chicks on the Run fabric line by Benartex



**Materials needed:**

**One Chicks on the Run fabric panel  
#3110-79**

**1/8 yard for orange sashing  
#3114-79 Spice**

**Bird house border, binding & backing  
#3113-07**

5/8 yard for directional cut LOF

**Cutting:**

**Orange sashing fabric**

2 1-1/2" strips

**Border/binding Directional fabric**

Cut off a 20" x LOF piece for backing

Then from the remaining fabric

Cut

2 2-1/2" strips x WOF (top & bottom)

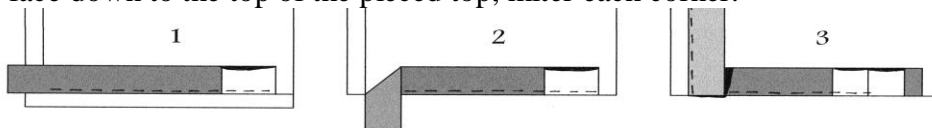
**Then cut from the remainder-**

2 2-1/2" strips x LOF (for sides)

And

4 or 5 2-1/4" strips x WOF (binding)

1. Trim the panel picture on the outside the gold edge all the way around, approx. 12-3/4" x 14-1/2".
2. Cut out the panel.
3. Sew one orange sashing strip to each side and trim the excess on the ends to match the panel.
4. Sew the remaining orange sashing strip to the top and then bottom and trim away the excess.
5. Check the direction then sew one LOF border strip to each side and trim the excess.
6. Press the seams as you go.
7. Sew the remaining WOF border strips to the top and bottom and trim the excess.
8. Lay the quilt top on a layer of batting and backing fabric. Quilt by hand or machine.
9. Sew the binding strips end to end, making a continuous strip of binding for the quilt.
10. Fold in half lengthwise, with right sides out, and press flat.
11. Pin around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the quilt.
12. Use scraps if more length is needed.
13. Sew the binding face down to the top of the pieced top, miter each corner.



14. Overlap the ends. Fold over to the back, pin, and hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.

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
