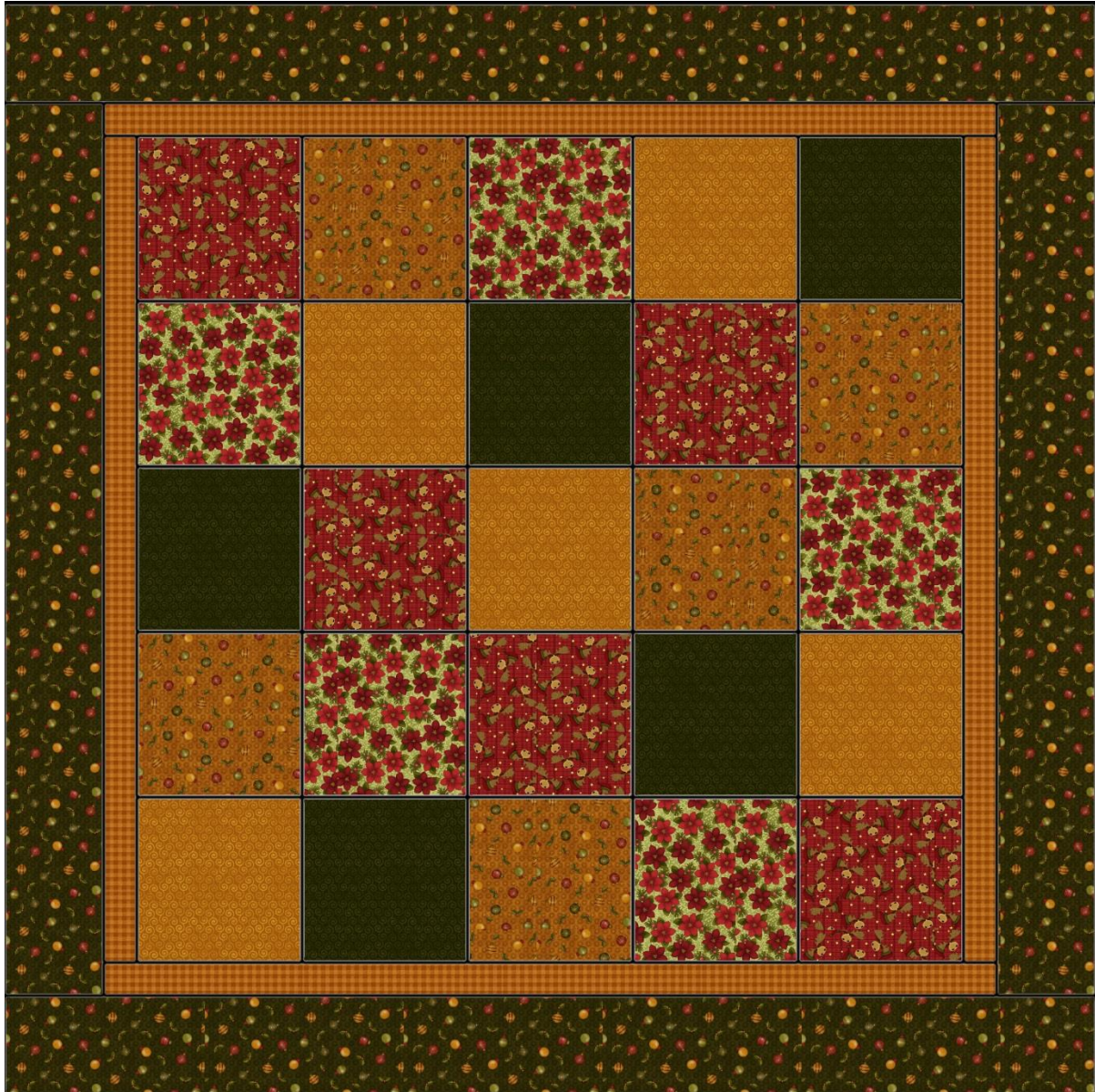


# Christmas Patchwork

31" X31"



### Materials Needed:

- 5" strip of #1541-10 Red Moose Head
- 5" strip of #4304-40 Green Scroll
- 5" strip of #1543-04 Poinsettia
- 5" strip of #4304-33 Gold Scroll
- 5" strip of #1544-33 Gold Ornaments

Border- 2/3 yards of #1544-45 Green Ornaments  
Sashing- 1/4 yard of #1542-33 Gold Plaid

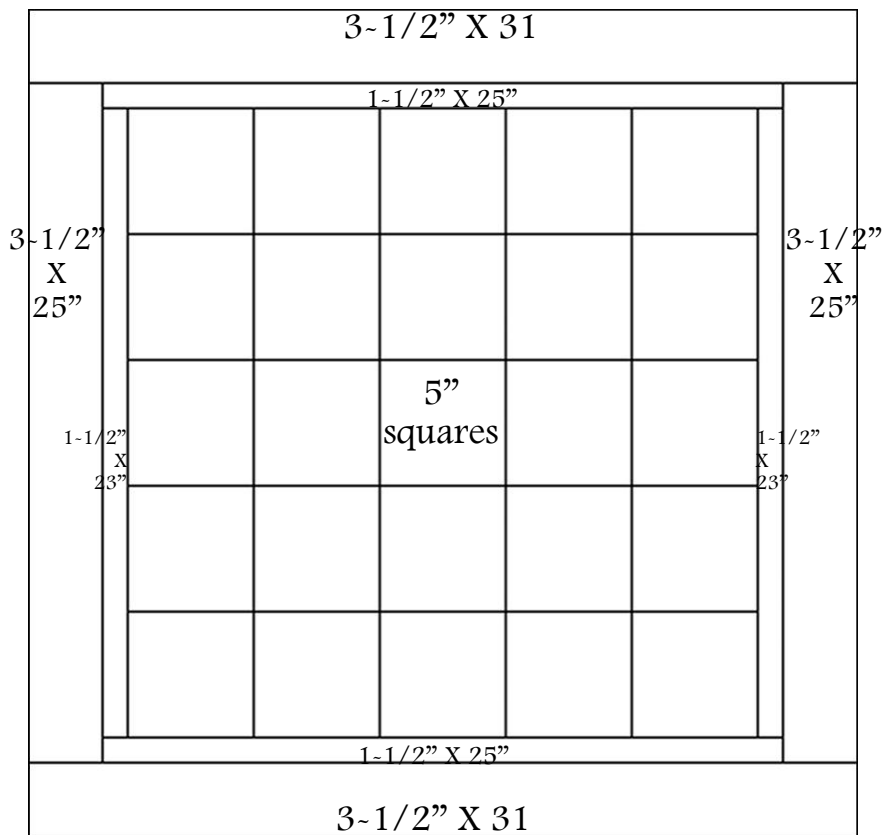
# Christmas Patchwork

## Cutting

Cut five 5" squares of each  
#1541-10 Red Moose Head  
#4304-40 Green Scroll  
#1543-04 Poinsettia  
#4304-33 Gold Scroll  
#1544-33 Gold Ornament

Border: #1544-45  
(Green Ornaments)  
2 3-1/2" X 31"  
2 3-1/2" X 25"

Sashing: #1542-33  
(Gold Plaid)  
2 1-1/2" X 25"  
2 1-1/2" X 23"



1. Line up five rows of five 5" squares.
2. Mix and match so no row contains the same fabric twice.
3. Sew each row across.
4. Sew the five rows together.

## Finishing

1. Sew the 1-1/2" X 23" sashing strips to each side and trim any excess.
2. Sew the 1-1/2" X 25" sashing strips to the top & bottom and trim any excess.
3. Sew the 3-1/2" X 25" border strips to each side and trim any excess.
4. Sew the 3-1/2" X 31" border strips to the top & bottom and trim any excess.
5. Lay the pieced top on a layer of batting and backing fabric.
6. Hand or machine quilt.
7. Cut three 2-1/4" strips of border fabric and sew end to end to make a continuous strip for the binding.
8. Fold in half lengthwise with right sides out and press flat.
9. Pin the strip around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the top.
10. Sew the binding face down to the top and miter each corner.
11. Overlap the ends. Fold over to the back and pin in place.
12. Hand stitch to the back.
