

Folk Art Flag Pillow Finished size approximately 11" x 14"

Materials

One Liberty Hill panel #2540-55 3/8 yard border/ binding/ backing fabric #2542-55

**Before cutting the border fabric strips, set aside a piece 13-1/2" X 16" for the pillow backing

- 1. Trim the panel flag picture outside the gold edge with $\frac{1}{4}$ " extra all the way around.
- 2. From the remaining border fabric, cut two 2-1/2'' strips from the length of fabric for the sides.
- 3. Cut two more 2-1/2'' strips from the width of fabric for the top and bottom border.
- 4. Sew the side borders and trim the excess on the ends to match the panel.
- 5. Sew the top and bottom borders and trim the excess.
- 6. Lay the pieced top with *right sides together* on the 13-1/2" X 16" set aside backing fabric.
- 7. Lay both pieces together on two layers of quilt batting.
- 8. Sew all the way around, leaving about 6" open for turning, starting and stopping on the bottom.
- 9. Trim the seam and turn the pillow top right side out.
- 10. Push the corners out and smooth out the seams.
- 11. Stuff with Poly-fil between the two layers of batting.
- 12. Hand-stitch the opening closed.
