

Moose Lake Welcome Pillow 14" X 14"

Using the Moose Lake fabric line by Benartex



Materials needed:

One Moose Lake fabric panel #5090-99

3" strip of tan fabric for the sashing- Weathered #5094-72 Tan

1/2 yard for the border & pillow backing- Fishing Toss #5092-44 Green

1. Trim the panel picture 1" into the green border all the way around.
2. It should measure approximately approx. 8-1/2" x 9" tall.
3. Cut two 1-1/2" strips of tan fabric for the sashing.
4. Sew one sashing strip to each side of the panel and trim the excess on each piece. Press as you go.
5. Sew the remainder of each sashing strip across the top and bottom and trim the excess.
6. Cut off a piece of border fabric 16" x 16" wide for the backing and set aside.
7. Cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips from the remainder of the backing fabric.
8. Sew one of the border strips to each side and trim the excess.
9. Sew the remaining border strip across the top and bottom. Trim the excess.
10. Lay the pieced top with right sides together centered on top of the backing fabric.
11. Lay both pieces on top of two layers of quilt batting.
12. Sew all the way around the edge starting on the bottom, leaving about 6" open for turning.
13. Trim the seam and turn the pillow top right side out.
14. Push the four corners out and smooth the seams.
15. Stuff with Poly-fil between the two layers of batting. Hand-stitch the opening closed.
