

## Garden Boots Table Runner 14" x 36"

Using the Sunshine Garden fabric line by Benartex



### Materials needed:

Two Sunshine Garden fabric panels #3490-50

1/8 yard for sashing #2774-44 Dark green

3/4 yard for border/binding with backing

Or 1/2 yard without matching backing

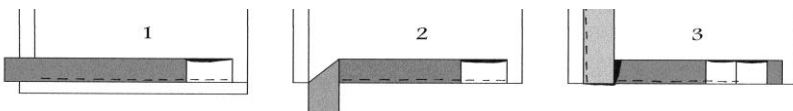
#3492-50 Blue

### Cutting:

Sashing dark green,	cut	4	1-1/2" strips
Border fabric, for backing cut		1	15" x WOF
For the Center strip, cut off		1	4" x 12"
Border	cut	2	2" x WOF strips
Binding	cut	3	2-1/4" x WOF **

1. \*\*From one 2-1/2" binding strip, cut off 30" and trim to 2" in length to use for end borders.
2. Set aside the other 2-1/4" x 14" strip for the binding.
3. Mark each panel picture outside the edge with an extra 1/4" around, approx. 9-1/2" x 13-1/2" and cut out.
4. Sew one green sashing strip to each long side and trim the excess on the ends to match the panel. Press.
5. Sew the remaining strips to the top and bottom of the panel and trim the excess.
6. Repeat for the second panel.
7. Sew the center 4" x 12" strip of border fabric between the two panels.
8. Trim each side of the center to match the panels.

9. Sew one border strip down each long side and trim the excess. Press as you go.
10. Sew the remaining 30" border strip to one end (top or bottom) and trim the excess.
11. Sew the remainder of the strip to the other end and trim.
12. Lay the quilt top on a layer of batting and backing fabric. Quilt by hand or machine.
13. Sew the binding strips end to end, making a continuous strip of binding for the quilt.
14. Fold in half lengthwise, with right sides out, and press flat.
15. Pin around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the quilt.
16. Sew the binding face down to the top of the pieced top, miter each corner.



17. Overlap the ends. Fold over to the back, pin, and hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.
