

Sunshine Bird Houses 13" X 28" Table Runner/ Mat

Using the Sunshine Garden fabric line by Benartex



Materials needed:

One Sunshine Garden fabric panel #3490-50

1/8 yard sashing #10076-79 Cinnamon

Cut 2 1-1/2" sashing strips

5/8 yard sunflower fabric #3491-52 Med. Blue
For border/ binding/binding

Border 14" x 30" for backing & set aside

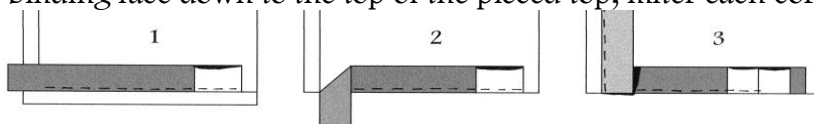
Then cut 2 2-1/2" x WOF for border

Cut from remainder of fabric

Cut 1 2-1/4" x WOF for binding

Plus 3 more strips from remaining WOF

1. Mark the panel picture 1/4" outside the blue background, approx. 6-1/2" x 22" wide & cut out.
2. Sew one brown sashing strip down one short side and the second sashing strip down the other short side. Press the seams as you go.
3. Trim the excess on both sides to match the panel.
4. Using the remaining partial sashing strips, sew one across the top and the other across the bottom.
5. Press again and trim away the excess.
6. Sew one border strip down one side and the second border strip down the other side.
7. Sew the remainder of each border strip across the top and bottom and trim the excess.
8. Lay the top on a layer of batting and backing fabric. Quilt by hand or machine.
9. Sew the binding end to end, making a continuous strip of binding for the quilt. Measure at least 84".
10. Fold in half lengthwise, with right sides out, and press flat.
11. Pin around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the quilt.
12. Sew the binding face down to the top of the pieced top, miter each corner.



13. Overlap the ends.

14. Fold over to the back, pin, and hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.
