

A Moose Goes Fishing Pillow 14" X 16"

Using the Moose Lake fabric line by Benartex



Materials needed:

One Moose Lake fabric panel #5090-99

3" strip of blue sashing
We used Scroll #3668-50 Denim

1/2 yard of blue border & backing
We used Moose Toss #5091-55 Blue

Cutting:

Light blue sashing-
Cut 2 1-1/2" strips

Blue border-
Cut 16" x 18" wide for the backing
& set aside

Then cut from the remainder-
Cut 3 2-1/2" x WOF for border

1. Mark the panel picture outside the tan edge with an extra 1" of green all the way around and cut out.
2. It should measure approximately 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" wide.
3. Sew one blue sashing strip to each side.
4. Trim the excess on the ends to match the panel.
5. Press the seams as you go.
6. Sew the remainder of the blue sashing strips across the top and bottom and trim the excess to match.
7. Sew one blue border strip to each side and trim the excess on both.
8. Sew the remaining blue border strips across the top and bottom and trim the excess.
9. Lay the pieced top *with right sides together centered* on top of the backing fabric.
10. Lay both pieces on top of two layers of quilt batting.
11. Sew all the way around the edge starting on the bottom, leaving about 6" open for turning.
12. Trim the seam and turn the pillow top right side out.
13. Push the four corners out and smooth the seams.
14. Stuff with Poly-fil between the two layers of batting.
15. Hand-stitch the opening closed.
